Who Can Come To Camp

All Cub Scouts and Webelos are invited to Camp Blazing Saddles. However, they must come with enough leaders/parents to meet the leadership requirements of the Boy Scouts of America. The best way to do this is for packs or dens to sign up as a group and share the leadership among parents and den/Webelos leaders (male and female). No Tiger Cubs or siblings please.

What You and Your Son/Den/Pack Should Expect

Blazing Saddles is held at Camp Brinkley, one of the Chief Seattle Council's premier camping facilities. Completed in 1967, Camp Brinkley has become the exclusive location for Cub Scout summer resident camping.

Sleeping at camp is either in tents with wooden floors or in adirondacks (three sided shelter) on wooden bunks.

The campsite is equipped with rustic bathroom facilities. There is a central shower house for everyone's use. Separate shower facilities are provided for female leaders.

Food is prepared by the camp staff and served in the dining hall — breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Camp staff is responsible for conducting all the fun camp programs and assisting leaders and parents with campsite activities. **Parents are responsible for supervising the Scouts**, getting the boys from station to station and other such tasks.

There is also a camp trading post with souvenirs, snacks, drinks, supplies and Scout products.

Cub Scout Summer Camp Fees & Due Dates



Cub Scout & Webelos Fee \$150.00
Leader/Parent/Den Chief Fee \$75.00

Keep in mind the BSA minimum standard of one leader/parent for every five boys (with a minimum of two adults – unless attending as a parent/son team). It is highly recommended that groups with Cub Scouts maintain at least a 1 to 3 ratio.

Refunds: The \$15 deposit is *non-refundable* unless the camping department is unable to reserve dates requested. Fees are *non-refundable* unless requested at least 15 days before camp. After 15 days before camp, refunds of up to 50% may be made in the event of accident, illness or **extreme** extenuating circumstances. All refunds must be requested in writing and received no later than 30 days after camp. **Refunds are not made at camp.**



Three Ways to Sign Up for Blazing Saddles

1. As a pack or den.
2. As a group of Cub Scouts or Webelos made up of boys from your pack or other packs.
3. As a parent/child team.



To Register

First: Fill out the attached registration form and send to the council service center with \$15/person deposits.

In Spring: Complete the medical form* (Class 1&2 for youth and adults under age 40; Class 3 for age 40 and up) and have current physical for **everyone** attending.

By April: Pay \$60/person by April 4th.

In May: Attend pre-camp meeting May 13th, 7:00 p.m. at the council service center. Final payment of \$75 per Scout due May 23rd.

Finally: Attend camp with medical form.
